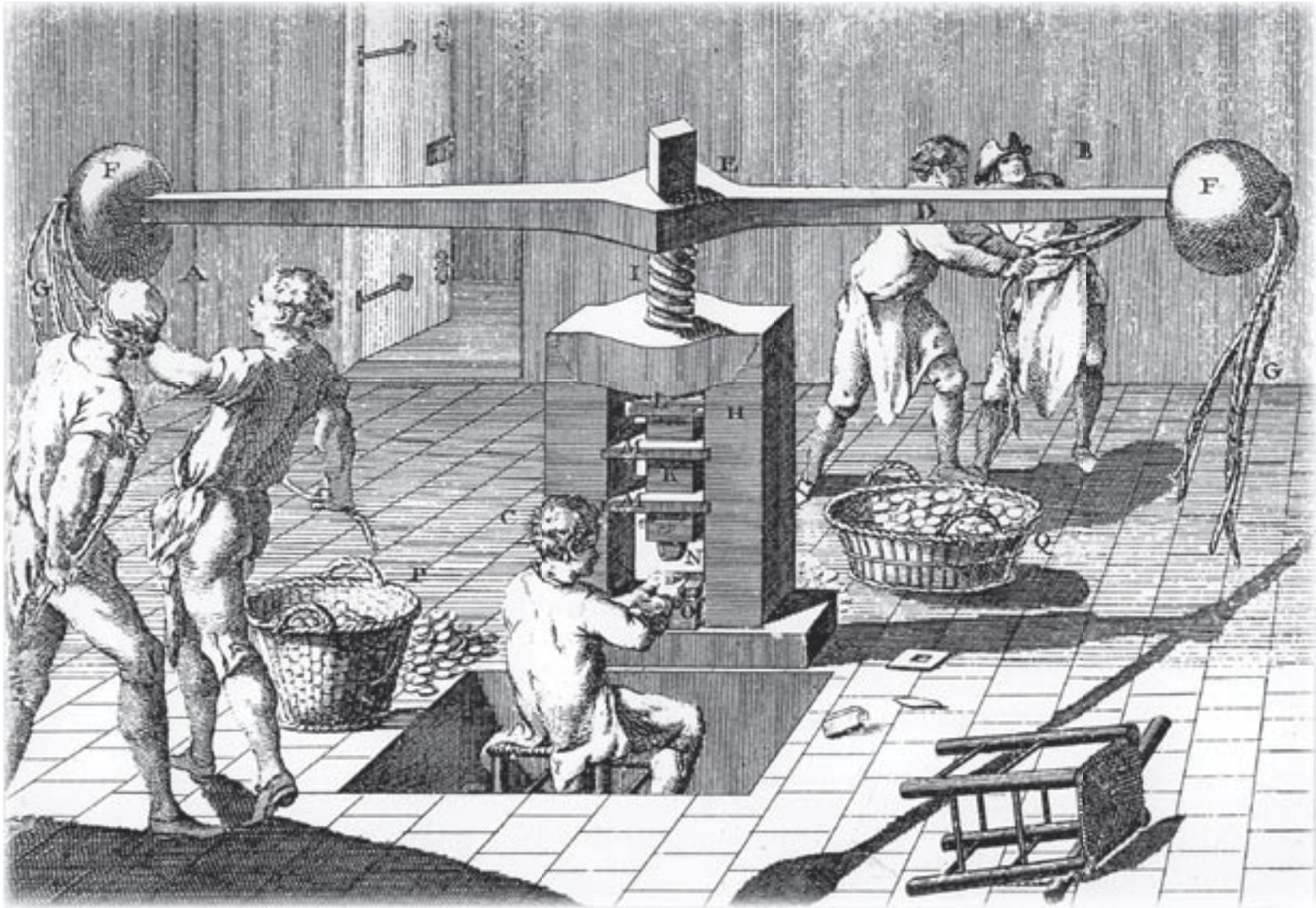

Puzzling Solutions
